COMPLETE STREETS INITIATIVE

The Complete Streets Initiative, including input from the Steering Committee and community stakeholders, led to the Trustees' adoption of the Complete Streets Policy.

The Policy (found on the website at www.shermanny.org) incorporates plans for safety, walk-ability, biking, and all other forms of transportation to be addressed when constructing improvements. The Village will take these priorities into consideration during street and trail specific projects, as well as adapting the Stormwater Improvements and other projects to meet the Village's Complete Streets objectives.
